

PRACTICE FACILITY RULES AND GUIDELINES

Hours of Operation: The facility will be open @ 6:30 AM each weekend and holiday morning; Monday 11:30; Tuesday (Wednesday 7:30; Thursday 10:00; and Friday 7:30. The facility closes on Sunday and Wednesday two hours before dark and Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday at dark. If the course is closed due to lighting, the facility is closed. At any other time that the course is closed due to weather conditions, the Golf Professional staff shall determine whether the practice facility is open or closed. On other days, the opening or closing may change as directed by the Pro Shop.

Use of Mats: Mats will be used on Mondays and during special events hosted by the Club (as determined by the Professional staff).

Eligibility: Miami View members and club-recognized direct family (i.e., spouses and children under the age of 25); Members' children must be at least 12 years old to hit balls while unsupervised by a parent (limited to 1/2 hour during heavy usage periods); Members' children under 12 (during lower usage periods) when supervised by their parent; Members' grandchildren under the age of 22 (must be accompanied by the grandparent) and limited to lower usage periods and a limit of 2 grandchildren per family at any one session; Guests of members on a day that they play golf (paying guest fees or using a guest pass); and participants in special events hosted by club (mats only).

Liability: Player assumes responsibility for hitting or damaging people, auto, buildings, etc. Any member or guest who willfully, or through negligence, damages club property will incur costs of repairs or replacement, and is subject to suspension or termination of privileges. All property damage, whether intentional or unintentional, is to be reported to the Pro Shop. Children below the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Use of Cart Paths: Riding carts must stay on the concrete path at all times.

Attire: Proper golf attire must be worn on the practice facility and practice areas at all times (no tee shirts, tank tops, jeans, cut-offs, etc.). Acceptable footwear includes soft-spiked golf shoes or rubber soled sport shoes.

Hitting Area: Golf balls must be hit from designated area.

Ball Retrieval: Do not retrieve golf balls.

Behavior: Inappropriate behavior or intentionally hitting balls outside the range area (parking lots/apartments) will not be tolerated. The potential penalty for inappropriate behavior is suspension of practice facility privileges for up to one year.

Divot Pattern: Do not destroy grass in one block area. This will aid in the bent grass recovery process.

Yardage: Measured daily to the colored flags and indicated on signage
