## **GOLF CARTS (Riding)**

- 1. Check signs regarding cart usage for the day.
- 2. Keep all carts (hand and power) off tees and slopes of tees and 30 feet from any green. All riding carts must be on cart path within 15 yards of green as designated.
- 3. Signs are posted daily near the first and tenth tees announcing the day's cart policy. They include: Scatter Carts can proceed toward the respective hole either on fairway, deep rough or cart paths. Carts can stop in the fairway while playing a shot. 90 Degree Carts are to use the cart path or deep rough to approach their ball. Carts can then make a 90-degree crossing, stop in the fairway, hit the shot then return to cart path or deep rough and proceed. Cart Path Only Carts must stay on the cart path at all times.
- 4. No more than 2 riders permitted in a cart.
- 5. Please obey all path indicators on the course.
- 6. Lock parking brake when vehicle is left unattended. Be sure parking brake is released during operation.
- 7. Do not make a sharp turn at high speeds.
- 8. The cart is yours for pleasure. Respect the condition of the turf and obey the rules so that the use of carts can be practical.
- 9. Children who are not licensed drivers may not operate power driven carts.
- 10. Riding cart fees: \$20 for 18 holes and \$12 for 9 holes.
